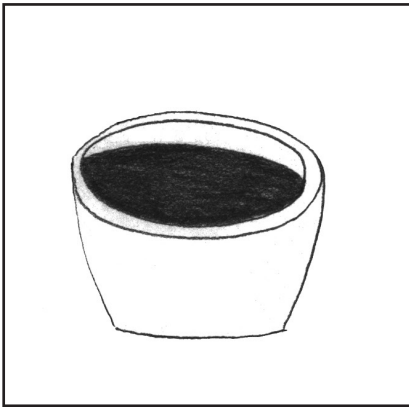


# Make your own scroll

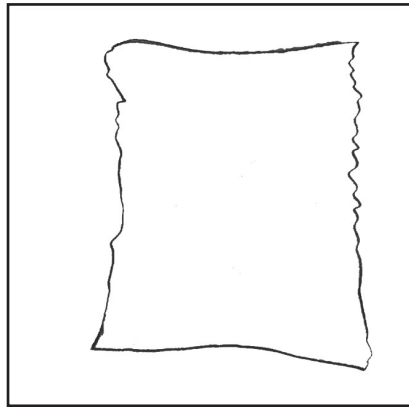
Elizabethan writing paper was not smooth and white, like paper today.  
So here's how to make your paper look the part.

## YOU WILL NEED:

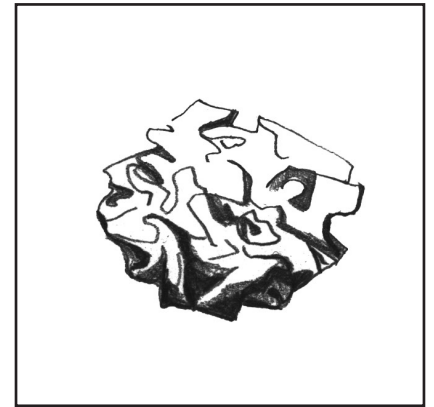
A teabag, a cup of warm water, a piece of cartridge paper, string or ribbon.



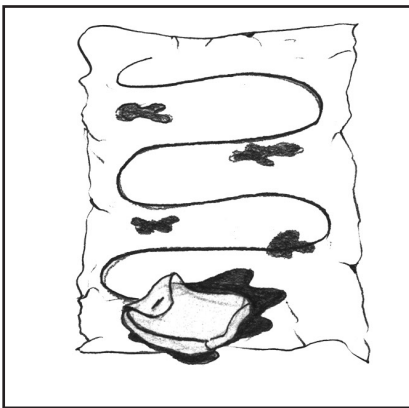
① Stew a teabag in a small bowl or cup of warm water.



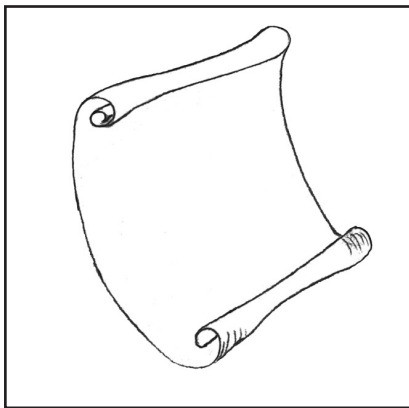
② Tear the edges of your piece of paper.



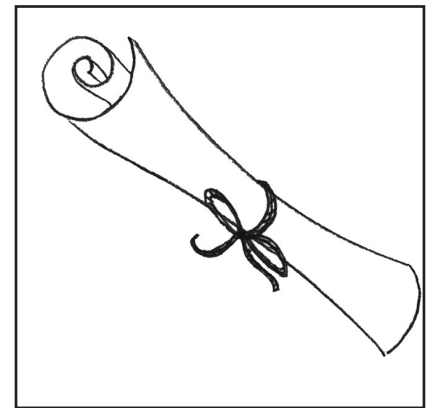
③ Now scrunch it up and flatten it out again.



④ Squeeze the tea from the bag onto your paper. Wipe it all over the paper and then let it dry completely.



⑤ Use an ink pen to make your writing look really realistic. Then roll up your paper to make a scroll.



⑥ Tie it up with a piece of string or ribbon.

*TIP: You could make your own quill pen from a large feather. Then you could write on your scroll just like William Shakespeare would have done.*
